SEASON X

BORDER X-SINGS: MAY 19, 2019

The San Diego/Tijuana border crossing represents the largest land border crossing in the world. This program explored our common humanity, culture, and issues of immigration and refugees throughout the world.

GENDER: X: MARCH 22-23, 2019

In this program we celebrated women composers and featured guest conductor Dr. Emilie Amrein and our own Assistant Conductor Lara Korneychuk. We also premiered the winning entry from Dr. Sarah Rimkus in our Gender: X Composition Competition.

EXCHANGE: FEBRUARY 16-17, 2019

As we strive to nurture enthusiasm for the choral art, we collaborated on a series of concerts with the L.A. Choral Lab, one of the most innovative choral groups in Southern California. We performed in what are considered the finest choral venues in both L.A. and San Diego!

XMAS: A HOLIDAY CONCERT: DECEMBER 14 & 16, 2018

SACRA/PROFANA put our own twist on Holiday programming and featured new arrangements of traditional Christmas carols, fun takes on Holiday classics, and contemporary pieces on themes of winter and solstice.

RETROX: A RETROSPECTIVE EXPERIENCE: NOVEMBER 2-3, 2018

Kicking off our 10th anniversary celebration, this program featured a number of our "greatest hits" from past seasons. Founding Director Dr. Krishan Oberoi and Artistic Director Juan Carlos Acosta shared conducting duties.

SACRED MUSIC / SACRED SPACE: SEPTEMBER 30, 2018

Returning to the FUMC Concert Series, SACRA/PROFANA presented a mix of familiar anthems and hidden gems of some of the finest in sacred choral music in one of the most beautiful sanctuaries in all of San Diego.

BUILDING BRIDGES SPANNING WATER: MAY 20, 2018

Water has long been a favorite theme of artists, poets and composers throughout the ages and crossing bodies of water is a primary functions of many bridges throughout the world. SACRA/PROFANA performed music with themes of water and bridges by some of the most important composers of the last 100 years.

BUILDING BRIDGES BETWEEN THE SACRED & PROFANE: MARCH 11, APRIL 15, 2018

This concert explored the gap between secular and sacred music by examining choral music with sacred texts that were written for secular audiences. "Profane" is often mistakenly equated with profanity, but in a historical context, it simply means that which is not sacred...in other words...secular. We performed music by composers such as Leonard Bernstein, Jon Kull (orchestrator for Avatar), Moses Hogan, Gregory Orban, and Brandon Waddles.

BUILDING BRIDGES BETWEEN NATIONS: KRENEK, BRITTEN, AND RILKE: FEBRUARY 23-24, 2018

This concert featured works by Austrian composer Ernst Krenek and British composer Benjamin Britten. Both men were part of a flood of composers, musicians, and others who came to the U.S. from Europe in the years before and during World War II.

RE-COVERING THE MUSIC OF CAROLE KING: JANUARY 19-20, 2018

Carole King is one of the most important artists of the 20th Century whose influence stretches well beyond her own recordings. Our program consisted of many of her hits made famous by other performers AND featured Tapestry, her iconic album. All songs were specially arranged by members of SACRA/PROFANA, approved and licensed for this special production.

THE NUTCRACKER WITH CALIFORNIA BALLET COMPANY: DECEMBER 9-23, 2017
SACRA/PROFANA was thrilled to once again lend their voices to California Ballet Company's production of Tchaikovsky's The Nutcracker. This San Diego Holiday favorite is one of the most well-attended productions of the season.

ALL IS CALM: THE CHRISTMAS TRUCE OF 1914: NOVEMBER 17-19, 2017

SACRA/PROFANA, Bodhi Tree Concerts, and San Diego Opera once again featured our men along with other noted local soloists telling the story of the Christmas Day Truce of 1914 through music and dramatic readings. Coming on the heels of Veterans Day, this was a great way to prepare for the upcoming Holiday Season.

BUILDING BRIDGES BETWEEN CULTURES: OCTOBER 20 & 21, 2017

Music is simultaneously one of the strongest identifiers of culture, as well as one of the common elements that help cultures come together. With this program, SACRA/PROFANA will be performing music that spans cultural barriers through style, language, and various musical techniques.
